A very Happy New Year to all Friends of St Britius

Thank you once more for supporting us over the last year and we hope into the future. We ended the year on a high note with two successful Christmas events and the news that English Heritage WILL help with the funds for Phase 2. Who would believe that two years into our appeal we have raised 90% of the total money needed. However, as you will see below, that still leaves us £42,000 to raise. We are hoping WREN (Waste Recycling Environmental Ltd) will give us a grant for approximately half of this, which would make the total amount still to raise not so daunting.



PROVISIONAL FINANCIAL REVIEW

The table shows the current position. We have completed the development phase for Phase 1 and contracted for the actual work which will start in September 2012. We have submitted our figures to English Heritage and await receipt of the grant monies. Work cannot commence until after the bat roosting season. We have been offered a grant from English Heritage for Phase 2 amounting to £17,000 towards the cost of the development

phase and £96,000 towards the actual work. English Heritage have been very generous. We will be able to reclaim the majority of VAT back through the LPW scheme.
