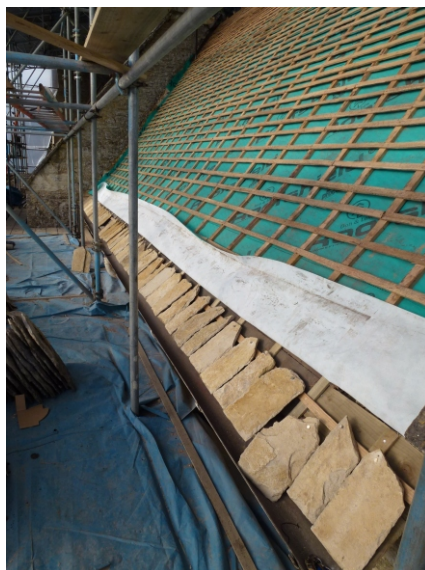
## ***"Stop the drips at St Brits"***

Please use the Gift Aid Declaration on the form if possible as this adds 22% to your donation courtesy of HMRC. You must sign and date the form to qualify.

Also please consider setting up an annual standing order or direct debit from your bank using the above information, so we won't have to approach you every year.
